LUMC Teaching Series with John Rempel Saturday April 9 – 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

"Applying Anabaptism Today: Where does it embody the Gospel? Where does it fall short of the Gospel?" This workshop will focus on the idea that 16th century Anabaptism was a corrective to Catholic and Protestant shortcomings. But a corrective is not the norm. How does Anabaptism today need a more balanced understanding and presentation of the Gospel? What are the current shortcomings of the Anabaptist vision? John will also speak about our changing understanding of church membership and how it might be renewed in our present day.

Involvements in peace making led to him become the liaison for the Mennonite Central Committee at the United Nations. He has also taught Anabaptist studies and historical theology at our seminary in Elkhart.
