- 1) Catechism lead by the PMT: Victor Winter, David Dyck, Mike Williamson Classes meet at 8:00am Sunday morning.
- 2) Reconciliation: Conflict Transformation for Ordinary Christians Teachers - Joel Warkentin, Randy Lepp, Location - Board Room What if reconciliation is central to the biblical message? How does this awareness affect our relationships with our family, friends, and neighbours? How does it transform our approach to conflict with coworkers and brothers and sisters in the Church? How does it refocus our solutions to the resolution of global conflicts? Does this alter our view of God? In a discussion format, this class will explore the biblical basis for reconciliation and begin to equip ourselves with tools for better understanding the conflicts in our lives.

#### *3)* Walking Together in the Word: Reading the Bible as Anabaptists Teacher: Mike Williamson - Sr. Singing Rm

Topic -*God has no boundaries: The Story of Jonah* This weeks class will discuss the story of Jonah. More then just a story about a giant fish, the class will reflect on its portrait of God who is *slow to mercy and abounding in stead fast love.* What does this mean for us? How does God's grace cross religious and ethnic boundaries? What is our role in sharing love and mercy?

4) Going on Vocation: Exploring work as it was meant to be. Teacher: Mike Groh, Location: Choir Room

#### Good News from Church Council!

After all the year- end numbers were tallied it turns out that not only did we meet our budget but actually had a small surplus. Come to the annual meeting to hear more details. Thanks to everyone who helped make this a reality!

#### LUMC Potluck Lunch & Annual Meeting - Sunday, February 28, 2016

Plan to join us for this important meeting. The minutes from last year's Annual Meeting are posted on the bulletin board for your viewing.

**Update on Front of Sanctuary and AV upgrade** - This past Sunday we enjoyed an excellent potluck lunch. Thanks to all who contributed to it. We then had a good turnout at the membership meeting at which the membership strongly endorsed Church Council's suggestion to fund the proposed changes and upgrade by accessing \$90,000 from the Bequest Fund, encouraging members to contribute to the project, and borrowing the remainder from the Mennonite Credit Union. At the beginning of January each member received a blue questionnaire which asked them to consider contributing to the project. Forty six members returned their questionnaire with the results as follows:

- 28 pledged a specific amount or made a payment which resulted in raising \$20,250
- 13 indicated a plan to support the project but did not pledge a specific amount
- 5 indicated that they did not wish to support the project

We will continue to accept pledges and payments but we will no longer use the box in the narthex. You can make your pledge by dropping it in the offering plate. Payments can be made by specifying – sanctuary renovations and AV under designated giving. Thank you for your support
