We are happy to announce that we have found a house, which is located in Kingsville, and are now in the process of furnishing it. It is a small house, so our need for furniture may not be great, but if anyone would like to donate furniture in good condition, please contact Mary Tiessen 519-326-2372 or Patti Russell 519-563-9901, and we will arrange to have it picked up. Uni-Fab, with Abe Fehr's leadership, is also sponsoring a family, and we will be sharing the donations of furniture with them as they are anticipating a family of seven. We thank everyone for their generous financial donations, our balance is just over \$15,000. If you would like to financially support this family, we encourage you to still do so. Lastly, we want to pass on that there is a great need for strollers in the Windsor/Essex area for the many refugee families that have already arrived, as there are many small children blessed to be starting a new life in Canada.
