October 29 - Education Hour - Living Well Mentally and Emotionally

This morning our guest speaker is Jennifer Klassen and her topic is Mental Health for Children and Youth. Although sometimes difficult to fathom, we know that kids have stress, too. Jennifer will discuss the current research around the stresses affecting our children and youth, focusing primarily on Anxiety,

Depression, and ADHD, as 3 of the most common diagnoses of childhood and adolescence. She will focus on the definitions of these disorders, including how they differ from adults, the treatment known to have the greatest impact, and the stressors that put children and youth at risk for their development.

Jennifer is a Registered Psychologist who works locally as a School Psychologist. She is currently the Mental Health Lead at her school board, while also owning a small private practice located in Essex.
