Education Hour - 11 a.m. - Living Well Mentally and Emotionally

We know that life can be very challenging and at times seem overwhelming. It is often hard to talk about these things even with those we are closest to. As a church we strive to be a community of hope and healing where people can find strength to live well. In our Adult Education this fall we want to take time to listen and learn about mental and emotional wellness.

Our guest today is Dr. Libby Skidmore and her topic is Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. Frightening situations happen to everyone at some point. People can react in many different ways: they might feel nervous, have a hard time sleeping well, or go over the details of the situation in their mind. These thoughts or experiences are a normal reaction. They usually decrease over time and the people involved can go back to their daily lives. Post-traumatic stress disorder, on the other hand, lasts much longer and can seriously disrupt a person's life. Dr. Skidmore will identify the ways that people can find relief from PTSD and go on to live normal lives.

Tuesday Evenings - Starting this week, Tuesday September 19 at 6:30pm Mike Williamson and David Dyck will be teaching. Bring your NIV Bible. Childcare for children in SK and up is provided by our Kids Club program. Entering the Way: The Good News of Jesus - The heart of Christian faith and spirituality is the life changing and world transforming encounter with the person of Jesus Christ. This 10 week class will explore the good news of Jesus, the meaning of the cross, the hope of his resurrection, the reign of God's kingdom and the impact this has for us and our world.

This class is open to everyone of all ages. Whether you are meeting Jesus for the first time, want to grow deeper in your faith, or are curious what faith in Jesus looks like in the 21st century, this class is for you.

Mennonite Disaster Service Response to Windsor, ON Flooding: Heavy rains in Windsor-LaSalle-Tecumseh in late August saw 6000 calls to the city from homeowners with flooded basements. After a disaster MDS often partners with agencies such as Samaritan's Purse Canada (SPC) and World Renew in the cleanup phase. During clean-up, homeowners not insured and needing further assistance will be flagged for follow-up. If required, MDS will continue in the rebuilding phase.
