In his own words; 'I am happy about being part of a community that seeks to understand and participate in what God is doing in the world through Jesus and the Holy Spirit. Doing so requires the full array of intellectual, spiritual, and relational gifts that God has given us.'

We look forward to Loren's teaching ministry in both the morning worship service and the afternoon teaching seminar.

"The Ethics of Worship" on Sunday afternoon will be a study of Revelation 4-5, which is one of the key sections for understanding Revelation.
