#### Winter Education Classes - 11:00 - 11:45 am Fear of the Other: No Fear in Love – 6 Weeks

**Sr. Singing Rm, Teachers: Erwin Tiessen, Glenn Sellick, Carolyn Warkentin** This class will invite us to consider the Gospel command to love (and not merely tolerate) those considered to be "Other" or outside mainstream Christian culture. Rooted in the faith of Israel and the Christian story and vision, this class will seek a non-technical, perspective to bear on what may be the hardest thing for people of faith to do: keeping and loving the Other as Other.

Emphasizing the biblical mandate to receive Others in their particularity and difference as gifts and mysteries bearing the grace of God, the class will invite us to an on-the-ground faith that hearkens to a soliciting and revealing God - the God who comes to us again and again through so-called outsiders, strangers, immigrants, and those without status.

## Encountering God: Reading Scripture Together - 12 Weeks Board Room, Teachers: Mike Williamson, Paul Dyck

Scripture. We can study it carefully. We can listen to sermons on it and read what the experts say about it. But in the end scripture needs to be encountered, rehearsed, and lived out with others. In this class we will encounter God anew and discern his actions and respond with our own by reading and listening to scripture together.

Following the scripture reading guide, each week we will immerse ourselves in a story about Jesus, examining the people, the voices spoken and words used in each story. Special attention will be given to how each story connects to our contemporary world and what each story reveals about the God who comes to save, make right, make possible, and give life.
