Mennonite World Conference (MWC)

Nepal was lashed by heavy rains for days in July, with the capital Kathmandu and the country's east hit hardest by the disasters. News reports some 200 people killed in India, Nepal & Bangladesh; hundreds of families have been displaced and thousands of families are badly affected by the heavy rains, especially in eastern Nepal. Local government and organizations like BIC Welfare Society Nepal in partnership with MCC Nepal are involved in rescuing people and providing relief. Some BIC Nepal church members in villages are also badly affected by the heavy rains. Pray that God may keep them from further damage from more rains and also provide for the urgent needs of the flood victims.
