Pray For ...

- We want to remember our young adults in their work and their studies. This week we pray for Joel Dyck who is studying at Heritage Bible College.
- In October, the island of Mindanao in the Philippines experienced a series of earthquakes, one of which, reached a magnitude of 6.5, killing eight people. So far 6,000 people are displaced. Mennonite Church Canada International Witness workers Dann & Joji Pantoja are safe but continue to feel aftershocks. Their organization, PeaceBuilders Community, Inc., is delivering donated water, food & clothing to people in the mountainous regions. They ask for prayer for injured and displaced people.
- Violence continues to disrupt daily life in Burkina Faso. This is a country where Mennonite Mission has been active for years now. Let us pray for the leadership of this country as they seek for peaceful resolutions to their conflicts.
- Our search continues for a Pastoral Ministries Team (PMT) member responsible for Children's Ministry. Let us all pray that God would guide this process and that a suitable candidate would be found by early January.
