- Pray for our Annual Meeting as we look back on another year of ministry and look forward to where the Spirit is leading in a new year.
- Andrew Dyck is completing a Mennonite Disaster Service assignment on the island of Saipan this week. He is helping to rebuild homes that were damaged in a typhoon that destroyed much of the island in 2018.
- Our youth group will be travelling to Hidden Acres Mennonite Camp this coming weekend for their annual retreat. Let's keep them in our prayers along with Pastor Zach as they spend time growing their faith and their fellowship.
- The coronavirus is disrupting the lives of many in China, including the ten North American
  English teachers currently serving with Mennonite Partners in China. The service
  workers and several of their Chinese colleagues left China in January for a mid-year
  retreat, held in Malaysia. Plans to return for university classes in February have now
  been put on hold as school officials are requesting that they not return.
