Road to Emmaus: Discovering Jesus in the Old Testament

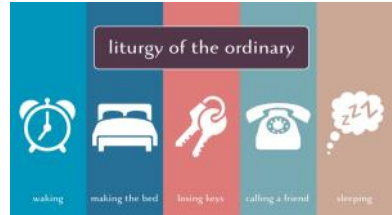
