Anabaptism at 500

On January 21, 1525, a small group of Christians secretly gathered in Zurich for a worship service. There they renounced their baptism as infants and experienced voluntary baptism as adults, now in the full understanding that this decision implied a transformation of life in the way of Jesus. For many, this decision led to imprisonment, torture, and even death.

But this gathering also marked the beginning of the Anabaptist movement that continues today in the form of the Amish, Hutterites, Mennonites, Church of the Brethren, and many other related groups. (Check out anabaptismat500.com for further information.)

Our own local congregations of Mennonites are also commemorating 100 years of Anabaptism in the Essex county region through 2024-26. The Essex-Kent Mennonite Historical Association has already begun celebrating this as they collect and highlight arrival stories in The Historian newsletter.
